“BUILDING A VIRTUAL CEMETERY – THE 114TH NYSV”

During its existence between 1862 and 1865, 1129 men served in the 114th New York State Volunteers. Now, thanks to FindaGrave.com, 833 of those men who spent three years together in war are together in a virtual cemetery. This presentation will cover building their roster, locating their gravestones and gathering them in the virtual cemetery.

Bruce Crandall earned his BA degree at Gettysburg College and his MA degree at Fairleigh Dickinson University. Before retiring Bruce was a teacher from 1964-2001. He is a member of Ellis Camp #124, Sons of the Veterans of the Civil War since 2006; Hastings Historical Society, Hastings-on-Hudson, NY since 1968. Bruce is also a compiler of “Historical Marker Database”, 4000+ historical markers, plaques and sites primarily in New York State; Civil War Soldiers Buried in NYS; 114th NYSV Analytical Spreadsheet; 124th NYSV Analytical Spreadsheet; Descendants of Elder John Crandall Who Fought in the Civil War.
