Kelly Eskew is currently the County Clerk for Orange County, being the 38th person elected to this position. The first person to hold this office was Derick Strom in 1702. The Office of County Clerk is an elected position that is voted on every four years. Kelly is honored to be given the privilege to serve all of the residents of Orange County, whose population has grown to over 390,000 since it was established in 1683.

Kelly has accomplished the transition to a more modernized advanced setting by having documents uploaded online, so that they are accessible to the public, from their home or office. So, whether your reason to visit the clerk’s office is to get a copy of your deed, a passport, open a new business, or a Department of Motor Vehicles service: you can be sure that Kelly Eskew and her helpful staff will be able to assist and answer any questions that you may have.
